

And celebrate, we will! First, be sure to review all of our links at "[Nawlins](#)" where you'll find a scrolling list of planned updates and the latest scheduled activities. Then you'll be ready to register starting this Saturday, February 3rd. Next the hotel booking process has changed slightly to offer an equitable opportunity for those obtaining lodging at our host facility. Therefore be aware that the simple instructions to reserve a room will only be available after receipt of your registration confirmation email containing your official Convention Number. You will first receive an acknowledgment and then a confirmation shortly after completing the online registration process. Just click on that special [here](#) link at the bottom portion of the confirmation email and you'll find a direct reservation phone number which connects you to our exclusive reservation manager during normal business hours at the host hotel. After verifying your Convention and NCCC #s she will proceed with obtaining your payment method to guarantee your room reservation. We certainly appreciate your understanding in this matter.

Now a few facts about our host facility. As you may have noticed, the name and brand alliance has changed from Best Western to Choice Hotels. Their transition is now complete and makes a nice place even better. And the \$87/\$119 room rates remain the same and now include breakfast each morning! The exceptionally friendly staff also remains the same. Our Hospitality Room and Corvette Mall will be on the 16th floor with a spectacular view of the New Orleans panorama. We will party hearty in the 8,000 sq. ft. Mardi Gras Ballroom, largest outside of the French Quarter. A couple of nearby Hilton properties have also been retained as overflow.
